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Dear colleagues,

We kindly invite you to participate in the first Ranunculacean International Seminar (RISE), which will take a place on 20-21 April 2016 in Lviv (Ukraine) on the basis of the State Natural History Museum of National Academy of Sciences of Ukraine. RISE is a first attempt to join together scientists studying Ranunculaceae in worldwide and, especially, in mountain regions.

RISE has been developed on the base of Modern Phytomorphology conference as open scientific seminar with both personal and distant types of participation. The seminar proceedings will be published in special volume of open access journal Modern Phytomorphology, and therefore RISE considers manuscripts with no page limits and accepts both short communications and full-text articles in English only. All received manuscripts will be reviewed by two referees and after accepting they will be published both as hard copies and as freely available pdf(s). Each of the participants, regardless of the type of participation, will receive one hard-copy of the volume by post or personally during the seminar.

Working areas

1. Biogeography and Conservation of Ranunculaceae
2. Experimental and Applied Research on Ranunculaceae
3. Taxonomy, Phylogeny and Evolution of Ranunculaceae

Working languages

English only

Types of participation

1. Personal participation – participant personally attends the seminar with poster, keynote or oral presentation of contributions. Presented data will be published as short communication or full-text article
 - a. Keynote presentation (25 min. presentation, 10 min. discussion)
 - b. Oral presentation (10 min. presentation, 5 min. discussion)
 - c. Poster presentation (5 min. presentation, 5 min. discussion)
2. Distant participation – participant does not personally attend the seminar and only proposes the manuscript (short communication or full-text article) for publication

For keynote and oral presentations please contact the Organizing Committee to hand your presentation files in advances during the registration or just before the meeting start.

In order to prepare your poster for the seminar, please follow the next requirements: maximum allowed size of poster: A0 – portrait (max. height 118.9 cm, max. width 84.1 cm). We advise you to use a minimum amount of text at your poster and to use color figures to present the results. Also, we advise you to set-up the poster such, that it can be read at a distance of about 2 m, this means a height of letters (small case) of approximately 10 mm.

Organization of seminar is financially supported by Rufford Foundation (RSG ID 16667-1) which covers participation of 10 persons. Therefore we are happy to inform that 10 participants, who will send the best manuscripts and will announce a desire to get financial support, will be able to take a part in seminar work for free. The grant is available for all of participants without regard to the type of participation. This grant, however, does not cover accommodation, travel charges, lunches etc.

All other participants should pay regular fees. Fees should be paid only after confirmation of acceptance to publication!

Fees

Total fee consists of organizing fee plus publication fee.

Organizing fee is 30 Euros (regardless of the type of participation).

Publication fee is 5 Euros per page (regardless of the type of participation).

In the case of submitting of several manuscripts the organizing fee is paid only once (as a result, participant will receive only one hard-copy of the volume). In the case of personal participation of several co-authors the organizing fee is paid by each of them (as a result, each of the coauthors will receive their own hard-copy of the volume).

In the case of personal participation, organizing fee covers organizational expenses, participant package and coffee-breaks. In the case of distant participation, organizing fee covers shipping expenses. The organizing fee does not cover accommodation, travel costs and lunches.

General requirements to manuscripts

Page number is unlimited; font – Times New Roman, size – 12 pt., indentation – 1.25 cm, 1.5-spaced, width fitted; margins 2 cm on all four sides. File format “doc” or “docx”. The file name should contain the first author’s name (e.g. – novikoff_text.doc). Text sequence: article title, author(s) name(s), institution name, postal address, e-mail, abstract and keywords, main text, references.

References in the text

For one author: (KONDRACKI 1978)

For two authors: (CAPELLETTI & POLDINI 1984)

For three or more authors: (CIESLINSKI *et al.* 2009).

Other accepted references: KONDRACKI (1978: 55-60), (KONDRACKI 1978a, 1978b, 1980), KONDRACKI (1978a, 1978b, 1980).

2. Receive the confirmation of acceptance to publication after review
3. Pay the fee by SWIFT
